Abstract

Building a serious digital product as a solo founder has become a coordination problem.

Solaigo proposes a different model.

1. The Coordination Burden

Existing tools optimize isolated tasks but do not address coordination between them. AI assistants provide answers, but not continuity. Automation reduces effort, but not cognitive load.

2. A New Primitive

With coordinated agents and preserved human oversight, a single individual can operate at a different level of abstraction.

One person can:

- design with clarity,
- execute with consistency,
- launch with intention,
- operate with discipline.

This is not about speed at any cost. It is about building things that can last.

- structured from the start,

- designed to grow.
